I'd like to serve again as Trustee of the La Jolla Community Planning Association. My interest in Land Development and other concerns in La Jolla continues as I follow them in the La Jolla Light and in the information I receive from the LJCPA eblasts.

I've been a homeowner here since 1969, living on Nottingham Place in the La Jolla Heights area of the Shores.
