

This letter is in response to your e-mail received by John Barlow, Council District 1 Representative, dated September 5, 2000. In your e-mail, you requested that the City of San Diego formally recognize the Design Guidelines, Eroscian Control and Maintenance Plan for Windamea Beach as submitted to my office on June 21, 1999.

The City of San Diego Park and Recreation Department, Chastal Parks Division, hereby recognizes the Design Guidelines, Erosion Control and Maintenance Plan for Windansea Beach as approved by the La Jolla Town Council on June 10, 1999. All proposed improvements and say changes to the plan will be reviewed by the La Jolla Town Council. The City of San Diego will have final approval of any improvements and/or changes to the plan. Projects requiring environmental documents and/or permits, will be required to be presented to the La Jolla Community Planning Association, and follow the Park and Recreation Department's advisory committee and permit process.

The Park and Recreation Department Grants Office is currently in the process of entering into agreements with the State of California for funds that have been identified for various projects throughout the Park and Recreation Department, including \$150,000 for the Windamsca Beach area. The purpose of the grant is to implement the "first phase" of the crossion control measures designated in the plan. The Grants Office anticipates having agreements with the State of California for all projects before January 2001. As soon as we have signed agreements, the process of design and/or construction can begin. My staff will work with the Friends of Windamsea in prioritizing a list of projects to accomplish the plan.



President Ann Dynes called the meeting to order, and thanked members who helped with the registering and supported the organizing of the Zoom conference call.

Report by Councilwoman Bru's Office — Steven Hadley thanked Brenda and her Friends of Coast Trail group for its organizing, repair, and maintenance of the Trail. He mentioned that City Parks & Rec news is changing daily, and there is much demand on City Council to open up Balboa Park, Mission Bay, and all parks. Steve was asked about the 'Slow Streets' update, and had nothing to add. Diane Kane did brief update

Non-agenda Public Comments—issues not on the agenda within the LJP&B jurisdiction (two minutes or less) – Brenda added information about Coast Walk Trail, and said work currently is happening Monday-Friday 7-3, during which the trail is partially closed. She reported they're still about \$4,500 short of funds for resurfacing, but the trail is very smooth now. All volunteers have been showing up, and they have received lots of help from Barbaras By's office and other support. She reported that wood will soon be replaced on railings along the trail.

President's Report – Ann Dynes mentioned the work done since the last meeting on the City's Parks Master Plan, which to be further discussed in item#1.

<u>Approval of Minutes from April 27, 2020 zoom meetino.</u> Passed 15-1(Janet dissenting)-1(Sally abstaining, saying that she did not receive them). Janet noted that only 4 benches repaired, not 10 as stated in Minutes. Minutes to be edited to show 4 benches.

Approval of Treasurer's Report - passed unanimously.

- 1. Ratification of ravised comment letter on Parins Master Plan Claudia Berenoweld organized and oversew a comment letter authritized in compliance with the Inkitel deadline, but City has now moved deadline to June 11. As a result, plans are undersay to get input from other community organizations and Claudia also received community input from the La Jolia Light outreach article. She described the Initial letter submitted of the City on behalf of LIPB and other organizations and requested approval of it. Motion to ratify the letter as submitted, passed unanimously.
- 2. <u>Windersea Behvedere proposal</u> Melinda Merrywestherfulm Nerl. Jim presented the project, and gave the background of Friends of Windersea. He showed the overall preliminary design and plan there, including detailed trail and overfook management and repair, and negleocement of Belvedere. Plans are going to be submitted to the City and the California Coastal Commission, and it will replace railings with post-and-chain along the coastins then; the new belvedere and other areas will be ADA complaint. Motion by Melinda for endorsement as presented, passed unanimously. More discussion and questions on the project followed.
- Payment of \$100 to Chila Cott for refinishing plaque Janet Collins! Whale View Point Fund.
  Janet explained the 'Cornellus' bench plaque was deamed up and polished by Chila Cott, and

They've been very euccessful in trail management, keeping people out of the busines, and for the vegetation regrowth and come-back. Motion to approve funds as presented, passed unanimously.
- 7. Request for funding for Children's Pool (CP) restoration project Phytie Minick explained and reviewed the background of the CP funds and previous donations and intent of dones. She ested that action be taken to ensure that the remaining funds (\$11,258.71) in the sub-account be epent only on the potential of renovation at CP. In the event that she is not around to direct the expenditure of these funds, she wants the record to be clear that there should be no other uses of these funds. In the short term, she would like these funds to be made excluded excluded toward establishing a scope of work for site renovation and repair, Jane read letter from California.
