I'm writing in regards to the proposed building of a Belvedere (Gazebo) at Windansea Beach. This project has been discussed at various LJP&B meetings with wonderful enthusiasm giving me the impression we were working towards an improvement that we could be proud of, but, sometimes instead of sitting in an echo chamber, we should be using our other senses, such as looking at the site, speaking to a affected Residents and listening to their concerns about said Belvedere (gazebo).

Kate Woods, a Windansea Resident, contacted me about the local residents concerns regarding the proposed project, I understand some people are reporting a "historic" Belvedere was destroyed and this project is only rebuilding said "historic" Belvedere, but times have changed.
