1. **T & T:** Dave Abrams, Brian Earley and Diane Kane met with City Traffic Engineer Gary Pence on March 17 to discuss additional truck limitation signage on Hillside Drive. Types and locations of additional signs are under study. A new project to correct the drainage channel dip at Hillside and Torrey Pines Road will commence shortly.
2. **The LJ Reservoir EIR Review Ad Hoc Committee** met with City Engineers on March 4 and March 11 to discuss alternative locations for the project that avoid or minimize impacts to trails and native habitat in the Open Space and that reduce truck/construction traffic and neighborhood disruption in the Country Club neighborhood. At the first meeting, the project objectives and engineering criteria that influence site selection were explained and five alternative sites were suggested for further study. At the second meeting, the initial 5 sites were narrowed to 3: 1) The preferred location in the EIR; 2) the current location of the upper reservoir, and 3) a private residence at 7362 Brodiaea Way that is for sale. The sites are being analyzed for suitability and impact reduction. The April 1 EIR deadline for public comments will be extended once again at the request of the Project Managers.
3. **Coastal View Corridor Ad Hoc Committee** is investigating city sources for information on existing view corridor easements and has asked the city for confirmation that if identified and submitted, obstructed view corridors will be remedied by Code Enforcement. CD 1 Community Representative Steve Hadley has not yet received any response from city units involved.
