### 7. 625 Wrelton (1109781, Khalil) Action

Applicant & DSD: (Process 3) Coastal Development Permit to amend Coastal Development Permit No. 91- 0400 for remodel and addition to existing two-story single-dwelling and roof deck unit to become a two story single-dwelling unit with a roof deck and penthouse consisting of a 186-square-foot first floor addition, 2,074-square-foot second-floor addition, 115-square-foot penthouse, and decks located at 625 Wrelton Drive. The 0.29-acre site is in the RS-1-7 Zone and Coastal (Appealable) Overlay Zone within the La Jolla Community Plan Area. Council District 1. DPR 11 Feb: REJECT, 8-0-1 "Ineligible for 50% exemption because of encroachment by unpermitted construction. Plans do not demonstrate compliance with 30"

height limit. Plans not prepared or presented by licensed architect or engineer, as required for 3 story building. 2 nd level encroaches over side setback. Plans appear inconsistent with one another and therefore are unreliable" Pulled by Khalil (new information about preexisting walls)
